We are pleased to announce that *tentatively* the **2020 Buffalo Central Terminal Train Show** will take place on Saturday, September 12 and Sunday, September 13, from 10:00am to 4:00pm both days.

We are fully committed to providing the safest possible environment for our vendors, attendees and volunteers. All public health regulations & guidelines applicable at the time of the Show will be followed and enforced during all phases of the event (set-up; operation & break-down). We expect these will include the wearing of masks and appropriate social distancing! Sanitizing stations will be provided throughout the Terminal!

We are, of course, highly aware of the current uncertain times. In order to make the Show a success for both you, the vendors, and for us, at this time we are asking you to provide us with an 'expression of interest' in returning as a vendor for 2020.
